



Chinese Course 1: offered to DUT Staff and Students FREE!

COURSE 1 --- BASIC CONVERSATIONAL MANDARIN (Level I)

This dynamic 40-hour course provides DUT Community attendees with elementary knowledge of Chinese language, Chinese characters and ability to speak basic Mandarin.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completing this course, the attendee will be able to:

- understand the Chinese language within a specific framework
- speak basic Mandarin in simple dialogue by engaging in topic related conversations
- write at least 100 Chinese characters
- begin developing language proficiency towards sitting a Chinese Language Proficiency Test like HSK, HSKK, etc.
- a broad Chinese Culture experience include Chinese Calligraphy, Tea culture, Martial Art, Paper-cutting, Chinese music. etc.
- a potential opportunity for the DUT staff to promote academic exchange and communication in China.



Chinese Course 2: offered to DUT Staff and Students FREE!

COURSE 2 --- CHINA AND CHINESE CULTURE

This interesting 40-hour course combines an introduction to elementary Chinese language with the opportunity for attendees to acquire a basic knowledge of China and Chinese Culture.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completing this course, the attendee will acquire:

- a broad understanding of and a general impression about modern China, Chinese people, Chinese culture, Chinese customs and Chinese languages, especially basic Mandarin
- an essential knowledge of how to study/live in China
- an insight into how to respond to situations in a culturally appropriate manner in China

COURSE 4 --- SHAOLIN MARTIAL ARTS

Those two lovely 30-hour courses provide the attendees with Chinese Martial Arts Action, fitness, and an insight into Chinese Martial Arts.

COURSES OUTCOMES

On completing one of those two courses, the attendee will acquire:

- a serial of Chinese Martial Arts like *Taiji* and/or *Shaolin* Boxing based on certain rules
- an efficient way to remain healthy & build up the fitness of your body by practice
- a better understanding of the spiritual essence of traditional Chinese Martial Arts.



Chinese Course 5: offered to DUT Staff and Students FREE!

COURSE 5 --- CHINESE TEA AND TEA CULTURE

This interesting 20-hour course combines practice course with the opportunity for attendees to acquire an elementary and comprehensive knowledge of Chinese Tea Culture.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completing this course, the attendee will acquire:

- a broad understanding of and a general impression on Chinese tea developing history and management, Chinese tea and religion, Chinese tea wares, Chinese fine tea and its story, and Chinese tea making, especially Chinese tea customs & tea customs in different countries
- an essential knowledge of how to proceed Chinese tea Sensory Evaluation
- learn Tea Ceremony of *Oolong* tea, Green tea, and Black tea through practice
- a precious opportunity to experience Tea Opera/Water Painting which having been a cultural heritage in China for hundreds of years
